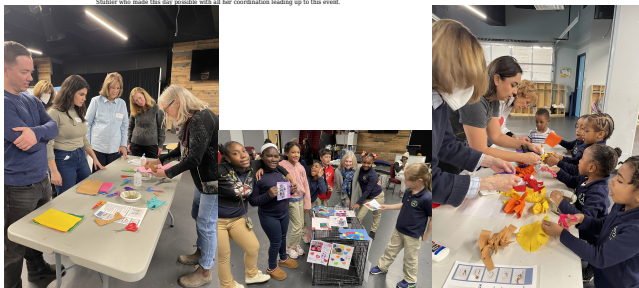
RSVP Today! Governor Kemp, February 23 Meeting
