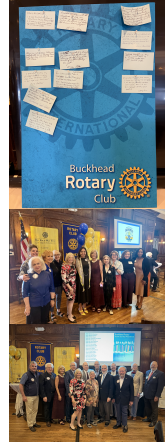

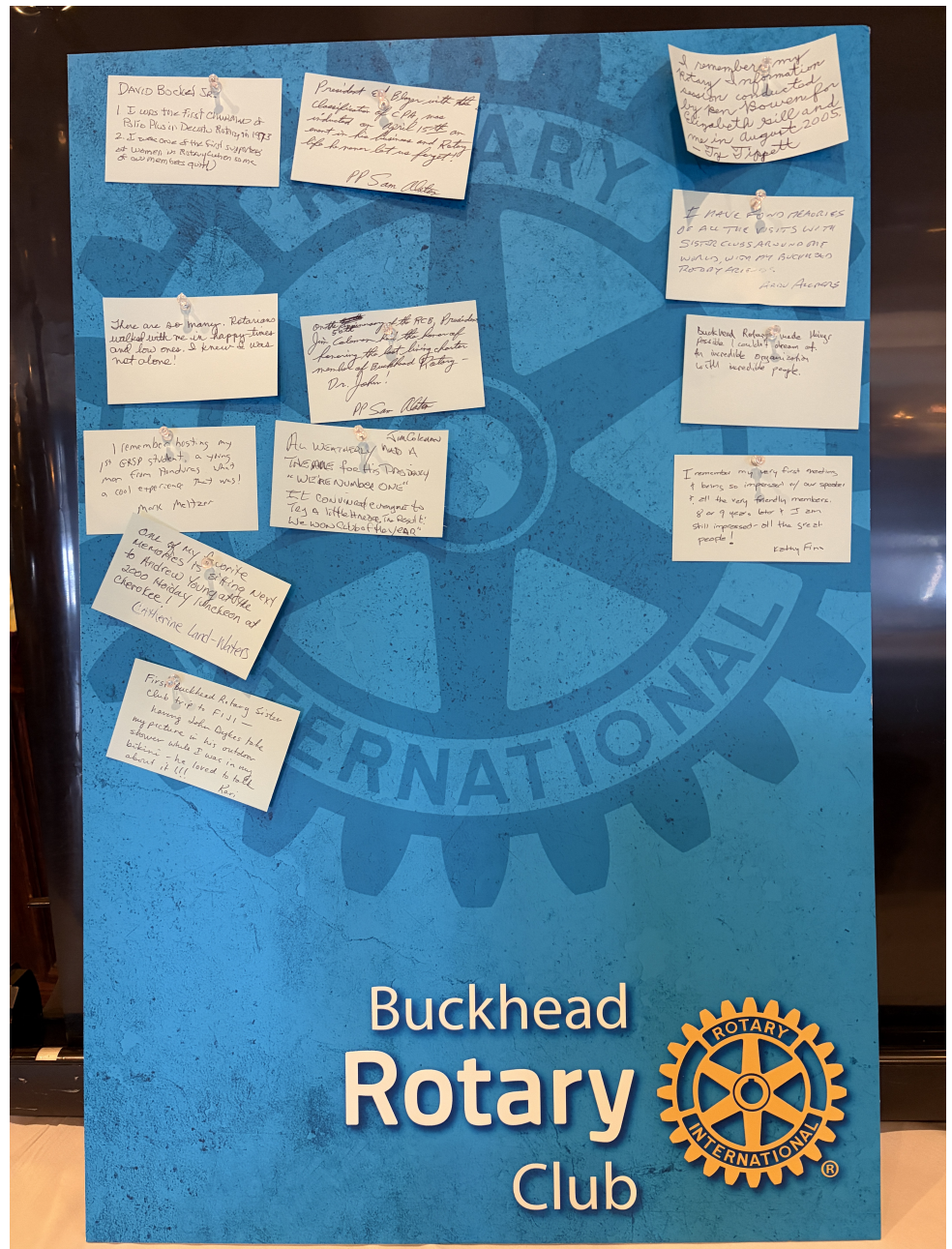

The biggest night of the year is almost here, the Buckhead Rotary Benefit, honoring Gary and Tia Stokan, is less than a month away!

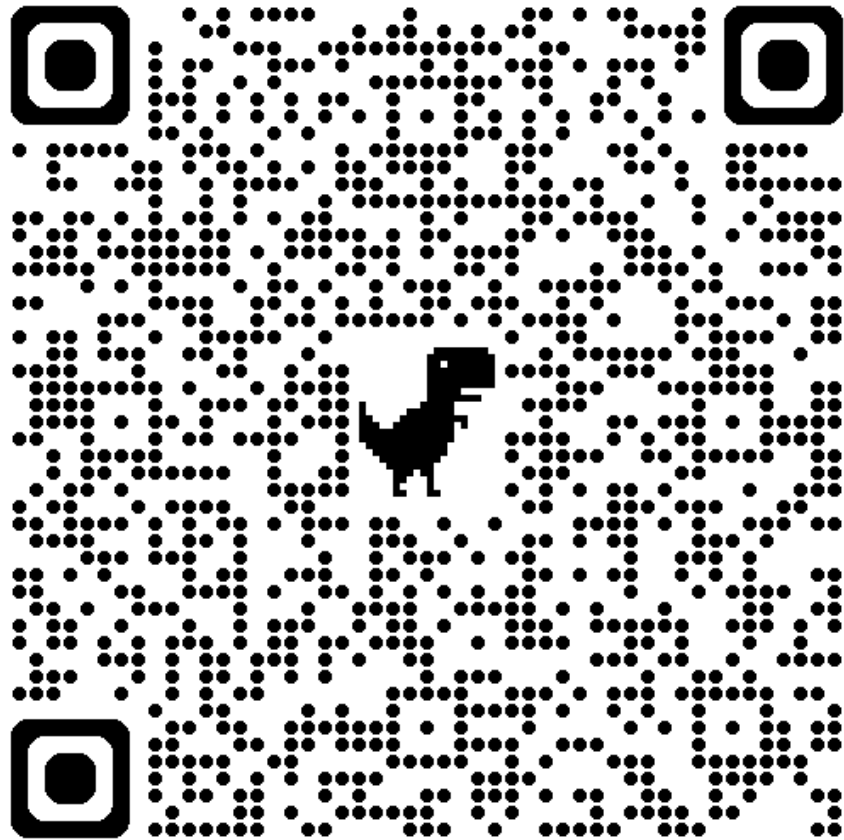
This special evening is our only annual fundraiser, providing the critical funds that empower us to support all our club's charitable efforts throughout the year.
